



#### Saiah 40:13-25

<sup>13</sup>Who hath directed the Spirit of the LORD, or *being* his counsellor hath taught him? <sup>14</sup>With whom took he counsel, and *who* instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding? <sup>15</sup>Behold, the nations *are* as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, he taketh up the isles as a very little thing. ... <sup>17</sup>All nations before him *are* as nothing, and they are counted to him less than nothing, and vanity.



2. Jesus is the Son of God (and not God Himself), born of a virgin through the Holy Spirit. The same Spirit anointed Jesus when he was baptised.

3. Jesus was born because of the (sinful mortal) state of the human race as a result of the sin of Adam.

4. Adam was the first man, created by God from the ground. Adam was a living being (soul) and had immortality providing he obeyed God's law.

<sup>6</sup>But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground. <sup>7</sup>And the LORD God formed man *of* the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and man became a living soul.



# 5. On breaking God's law, man was subject to death.

6. God has a plan that allows man to populate the world as sinless immortals without setting aside the law of sin and death.

And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes, and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.



7. He began by making promises to Adam, Abraham and David. He gave more detail through the prophets. These are recorded in the Bible.

<sup>4</sup>As for me, behold, my covenant *is* with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. <sup>5</sup>Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham, for a father of many nations have I made thee. 6And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.



- 8. The promises spoke of Jesus Christ who would be raised in the line of Abraham and David and would live a perfectly obedient life. Through His death and resurrection the law of sin and death for himself and those that follow him would be abolished.

9. To accomplish this Jesus was miraculously conceived. Born Son of God and son of man enabled Jesus to bear our nature and be sinless. Therefore he is the only one who could suffer death and rise again.

Now when Job's three friends heard of all this evil that was come upon him, they came every one from his own place; Eliphaz the Temanite, and **Bildad the Shuhite,** and Zophar the Naamathite: for they had made an appointment together to come to mourn with him and to comfort him.

10. Being begotten of God Jesus was Emmanuel, 'God with us'. Because he was also the son of man he suffered as a man and was crucified.

11. Jesus told the Jews (his kinsmen) to repent and return to God's ways. He told them of the Gospel (good news) and that God would restore their kingdom and fulfil the promises He made through the prophets.

12. For telling them this good news Jesus was put to death. The Jews and Romans were God's instruments in order to destroy the power of death. Jesus was offered once for us all for the remission of sin. All who approach God through Jesus are forgiven. Therefore figuratively blood cleanses from sin.

13. After three days God raised him from the dead. God set Jesus next to Him as priestly mediator between Himself and man.

<sup>3</sup>For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures, <sup>4</sup>And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:



♥ 14. Jesus is priest for his house only (his believers) providing they confess and forsake their sins. He does not intercede for the world.

He had not consented to their decision and deed. He was from Arimathea, a city of the Jews, who himself was also waiting for the kingdom of God.



#### 15. Jesus appointed apostles to spread the message that only through him man can be saved.

16. Salvation is through belief in the Gospel and taking up service to Jesus. Baptism (full immersion) is the public display of this commitment to a life in Jesus.

<sup>47</sup>For so hath the Lord commanded us, *saying*, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. <sup>48</sup>And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.



#### 17. The Gospel consists of "The things concerning the Kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ."

<sup>12</sup>But when they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptised, both men and women.



#### 18. The 'Things concerning the Kingdom of God' are the facts presented to us by the Apostles and the Prophets, as follows...



#### 19. God will establish His kingdom in the earth and overthrow all others.

### ♥ Daniel 2:44

<sup>44</sup>And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, *but* it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.



# 20. To achieve this God will send Jesus to the earth in person.

And when they could not come nigh unto him for the **press**, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay.

21. The Kingdom he will establish will be the Kingdom of Israel in the land given to Abraham as an 'everlasting possession' by covenant.

#### Wichah 4:6-8

- <sup>6</sup>In that day, saith the LORD, will I assemble her that halteth, and I will gather her that is driven out, and her that I have afflicted, <sup>7</sup>And I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall reign over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever.
- And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion, the kingdom shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem.

22. This restored kingdom will involve the ingathering of God's chosen but scattered nation, the Jews. They will be reinstated in their reclaimed promised land. Jerusalem will be 'the throne of the Lord' and centre of the whole earth.







<sup>12</sup>And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.



23. The governing body of this restored Kingdom will be the brethren of Christ of all generations with Christ as their head. These will include the 'collective seed of Abraham' in whom 'all nations will be blessed'.

24. Prior to Christ establishing the Kingdom the 'responsible' (those who know the will of God) both the living and the dead, obedient and disobedient, will be brought before His judgement seat to be judged and to receive 'according to what they have done', good or bad.

♥25. Those unfaithful will suffer shame and the 'second death'. The faithful will receive immortality and will reign with Jesus as joint heirs of the Kingdom.

28. The purpose of the Kingdom of God is to subdue all enemies and finally death itself. All nations will be able to access the way of life.

29. At the end of the thousand years there will be a second resurrection. The wicked will be extinct and the faithful will be immortalised.

30. Finally the Kingdom will be delivered up by Jesus to the Father who will fill the earth with His glorious light, and dwell amongst His faithful creation, man.


